FCCLA MEMBERS MAKE AN IMPACT

On a national scale:

- 85% of FCCLA members have a 3.0 or higher GPA
- 73% of FCCLA members take advanced courses
- 59% of FCS teachers believe FCCLA has made teaching more meaningful and engaging to students

FCCLA MEMBERS LEARN EMPLOYABILITY SKILLS

- Developing teamwork, creativity, leadership, responsibility, and time management skills
- Practicing and demonstrating technical skills for FCS-related careers
- Learning directly from industry professionals
- Exploring opportunities to practice and develop these skills



1,330 MEMBERS

Over the past year, Nevada FCCLA has nearly doubled membership affiliation, increasing from 724 members to 1,330. Nationally, FCCLA has 200,000 members.
