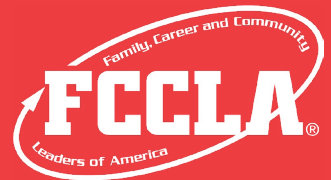

Nevada's top winners will head to NLC to compete for a winning spot on the International stage.

Below is a typical judge schedule:

### FIRST HOUR:

- Check-In and Orientation (with light breakfast)

### APPROXIMATELY 3 – 4 HOURS:

- Evaluate Student Competitions (with a Meal Voucher Included)

### END OF JUDGE DAY:

- Depart knowing you have helped the next generation of future business professionals!
